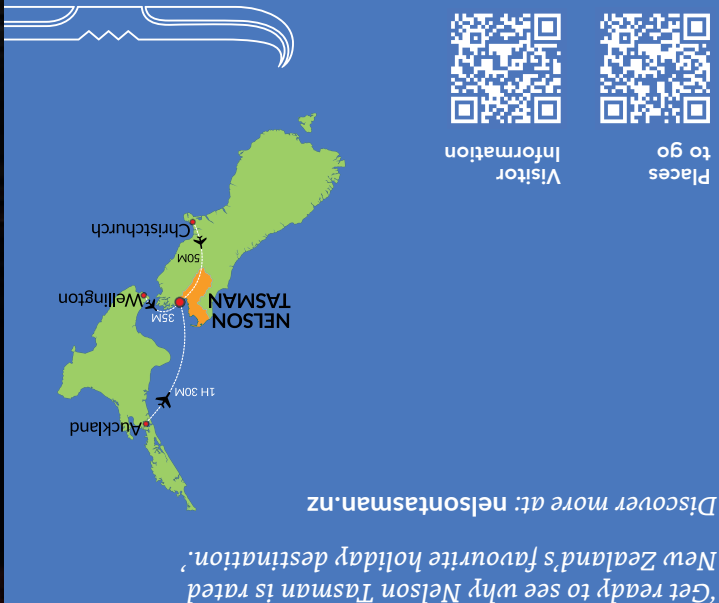

CYCLING

Nelson Tasman's big, beautiful trail network is known as Tasman's Great Taste Trail – 200km of coastal and cross-country riding taking in vineyards, cafes, galleries and more. Short, easy rides are definitely on the menu as are multi-day rides staying overnight along the way.

Highlights include tranquil Moturoa | Rabbit Island, Māpua village, and Motueka to Kaiteriteri, which dishes up cafes and fruit stalls. Historic railway sections offer peaceful pedalling and the remarkable Spooners Tunnel.

Our region is a mecca for mountain bikers year round, with internationally gold-rated trails just minutes from the city. Brilliant biking includes the Coppermine Trail Great Ride, Koata Park and Waitarake trails, with an après-bike scene that's every bit as epic.

Other drawcards include Cable Bay Adventure Park, Kaiteriteri Mountain Bike Park, Wairoa Gorge, Silvan Forest and, if your heading over the hill to Golden Bay, don't miss the Rameka and new Pikikirunga track.

If you're looking for multi-day rides through remote wilderness, try the Heaphy Track (May-Nov), or use Nelson as a gateway to The Old Ghost Road or Paparoa Trail – both open all year.

WALKING & HIKING

ABEL TASMAN NATIONAL PARK Beaches, bush and bliss

Come and discover a coastal gem where you can go slow, bathe in bush and beach vibes, and enjoy all kinds of adventures on land and sea.

The Coastal Track Great Walk is spectacular year round and particularly tranquil outside of summer. Popular kayak trips take in hidden coves, inlets and spectacular rock forms, plus the chance to encounter dolphins and seals. Day cruises, Māori waka (canoe) trips, river canyoning and scenic flights are other rewarding ways to see the sights.

Tour operators and water taxis make getting around a breeze, and overnight stays are offered in waterfront lodges, DOC huts and campsites. Regional transport connections include the Better Bus (from Nelson, Mārahau & Kaiteriteri; Oct–May). Book in advance for all services, whatever the season.
